

BARK PLACE was created as a joint venture between the DCR and the Friends of Breakheart Reservation. Each sharing in the costs of construction and maintenance.



It is the only area in Breakheart where dogs are allowed off leash, and is reserved for the use of dogs and their people.

We hope you enjoy using it and we welcome your suggestions and comments.

BARK PLACE RULES

- No female dogs in heat or pups under 4 months old.
- A maximum of two dogs per handler.
- All dogs must be licensed, vaccinated and wear visible license tags.
- Dogs must be on leash when entering or leaving Breakheart Reservation.
- Dogs must be under the control of their handler and in view of their handler at all times.
- Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Handlers must have possession of a dog leash at all times.
- Handlers must remove their dogs waste and place it in the proper receptacles.
- Handlers must fill in all holes dug by their dogs.
- No food or drinks in glass containers. Training treats are allowed.
- No animals other than dogs are allowed in the area.
- Handlers are responsible for any injuries caused by dogs under their control.
- Users of this facility do so at their own risk. Neither the DCR or the Friends of Breakheart Reservation shall be liable for any injury or damage caused by any dog in the off-leash area.

FROM WAKEFIELD: take left hand road, follow it to the lake, bear left and follow to Bark Place sign on your left.

FROM SAUGUS: take the road to the right of the Visitor's Center and follow to Bark Place sign on your right.
